I think of tossing a coin to include some of the events and eliminate others because the whole thing is so intellectually challenging, exciting, exasperating and exhausting. However, after endless deletions, inclusion and self inflicted selection agony I am highlighting only those events which were extraordinarily prominent.

Academics:

Aristotle had stated categorically, "All who have meditated on the art of governing mankind have been convinced that the fate of empires depends on the education of its youth". Perseverance, patience and perfection sums up the academic sphere of the School. SRItes brilliant performance at AISSCE (XII) and AISSE (X) levels have proved the fact that they were head and shoulders above the contemporaries. Mas. Harshit Gangwar (Science Stream) secured 93.4% and topped in AISSCE & Miss. Ishika Agarwal (Commerce Stream) secured 92%. The board result was 98%. In AISSE Mas. Aditya Tyagi secured 97.2% and 31 students secured above 90% marks. The result was cent percent.

Extra Curricular Activities:

Roll Ball Championship:

Our team participated in 12 Junior UP State Roll Ball Championship, held at S.R. International School, Bareilly (Under 17 Boys). From 13-15 May 2018 and won second position.

12 Junior National Roll Ball Championship organized by Roll Ball Federation of India at Sangaria, Rajasthan from 01-03 June 2018 onwards. Pushpam Patel and Faraz Khan and won first position 6th time in a Row and set a National record of winning maximum gold in National Championship.

All India Federation Cup 2018 held at Gauhati, Assam from 19-23 May 2018. Paushpam Patel participated and won third position.

12 sub-junior National Roll Ball Championship (Under 14) organized by Roll Ball federation of India at Balwati Stadium, Pune, Maharashtra. From 13-15 September 2018 Meran Nasir won third position and Sujat Khan and Sparsh Sharma won second position.

Our players made a world record of 48 hours Non-stop skating, held at Shiv Ganga Roller Skating Club, Begaum, Karnataka. They set the Genius world record and the Asian Record in Asia Book of Records.

National School Games of India 2018-19 (Under 14) held at Rajgarh, Chattisgarh from 19-22 Dec 2018 Meran Nasir, Siyat Khan and Angad Singh from our school participated in All India CBSE team and won second position

64 National School Games of India 2018-19 (Under-17) held at Bilaspur, Chattisgarh from 26-29 Dec 2018 Pushpam Patel represented from All India CBSE team and won second position.

U.P. State Senior Roll Ball State Championship 2018 held at Meerut from 31 August 2018 to 2 September 2018 and our team won third position.

Football Achievements:

Our an school team Participated at 7-A Side Football Tournament held at Templton School Nainital. Two students were selected in Under-16 State Championship for Bareilly Team. Mr. Steve Wright Our Coach participated in Asian Football Championship as a referee held at Agra.

Taekwondo Achievements:

In 4th Bhagwan Mahaveer Open National Taekwondo Championship Ishu Upadhyay, Akshat Gupta, Maninder Singh won gold medals and Taranpreet Singh won Bronze Medal.

In Open U.P. State Sub Junior Cadet Junior Taekwondo Championship event 2018 Saksham Sharma won Gold medal in Sub Junior Poomsae.

In 36th U.P. State Junior Taekwondo Championship held at Kanha Palace Nazibabaad Bijnor (U.P.) Taranpreet Singh bagged Silver Medal.

In 36th Sub Junior and 4th Cadet U.P. State Taekwondo Championship, Lucknow (U.P.) held at Agarwal College Moti Nagar, Lucknow Saksham Sharma 2 Silver, Arsh Rana 1 Silver & 1 Bronze , Utkarsh Singh Tomar 1 Sivler, Bhumi Bakshi 1 Bronze Ishu Upadhyay 2 Bronze, Maninder Singh and Naman won 1 Bronze Medal.

Cricket: On 7th May 2018 in Inter School Cricket Tournament held at Gangasheel Stadium, S.R. International School locked horns with Rohillas International School and S.R. International School won by 128 runs.

On 13-16 September 2018, S.R.M.S. Cricket Tournament was held at S.R.M.S. Cricket ground S.R. International School played against Radha Madhav Public School and S.R. International School won by 11 runs, S.R. International School also played St. Francis School won the by 5 wickets and S.R. International School V/s Padmavati Academy and S.R. International School was runner up.

Two boys of our school Jasdeep Singh and Ayush Singh selected in Under-14 Bareilly Cricket Zone Team.

Skating: In All India Speed Skating Championship at FITCO Sports Academy, Gurugram on 28-29 July 2018 we won 3 Gold, 5 Silver and 4 Bronze Medals. An SRite Master Ranvijay made a niche in the annals of skating. At the tender age of two years 29 days, in the category of under four and below, he wheeled ahead of all and bagged tow gold medals.

In All India Invitational Roller Skating Championship held at Swami Vivekanand Subharti University Meerut on 3-4 November 2018 SRites won 3 Gold, 3 Silver and 3 Bronze Medals.

In Roller Hawks National Speed Skating Championship at Punjab University, Chandigarh on 1-3 January 2019 we won 1 Gold, 3 Silver and 1 Bronze Medals.

Seminarss and Workshops:
